IMPORTANT NOTES

*Only trailers for boats stored at the Club (wet or dry) can be considered. The members name must be clearly marked on the trailer. Unidentified trailers may be removed from the dingy park and sold or scrapped with no further notice.

NB: Where an allocation of a mooring/storage space is granted after 1st March , payments are due within 30 days at the higher rate

BYELAWS OF PARTICULAR NOTE

- The Hon. Harbourmaster reserves the right to change moorings and to move boats as necessary.
- The Club may dispose of boats for which mooring fees are more than three months in arrears.
- Boats must be properly looked after and used reasonably or the Harbourmaster may demand their removal.
- Owners are responsible for maintaining their allocated mooring.
- Particular attention must be paid to maintaining a mooring bridle at its correct length, which is the same as the mooring length.
- All cruisers, dinghies and trailers must be clearly marked with their identity. Trailers must be marked with owners name.
