*Only trailers for boats stored at the Club (wet or dry) can be considered. Trailers must be indelibly marked such a as to make clear the identity and contact details of the owner – ie members name, telephone contact No.

Trailers not marked with the member's name may be removed and sold or scrapped with no further notice.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Members are reminded that moorings are allocated by the Committee through the Harbour Master. The allocation of a mooring does NOT provide any ongoing or assignable right to any particular mooring space.

Where an allocation of a mooring/storage space is granted subsequent to 1st November payment must be made within 2 months of the allocation to qualify for the discounted rate.

BYELAWS OF PARTICULAR NOTE

- The Hon. Harbourmaster reserves the right to change moorings and to move boats as necessary.
- The Club may dispose of boats for which mooring fees are more than three months in arrears.
- Boats must be properly looked after and used reasonably or the Harbourmaster may demand their removal.
- Owners are responsible for maintaining their allocated mooring.
- Fore and aft buoys must be tied together before a boat is removed from its mooring.
- All cruisers, tenders and trailers must be clearly marked with their identity.

PAYMENT

Please return the completed form together with a cheque, made payable to "Twickenham Yacht Club", to the Harbourmaster at the Clubhouse, Riverside, TwickenhamTW1 3DL. Payments in excess of £150 may be made in four equal instalments on 1 November, 1February, 1 May, and 1 August if four cheques made out for these dates accompany the application form. You are reminded that this qualifies for the discounted rate only if the payment (as described) is received before the 31 December.

Declaration

I declare that I will abide by the Twickenham Yacht Club General Mooring and Racing ByeLaws, in particular the requirement that my boat will be insured at all times.

I agree that failure to observe these Byelaws may mean my place is forfeited

I understand that this application is only for the current year and must be reapplied for annually.
